

(Grade. 4) Dance—Ballet, Contemporary & Family Waltz (All gender)

Dance 4 emphasizes both the technical and artistic aspects of ballet and contemporary dance. Students study primary Vaganova Ballet Technique along with basic Graham and Horton techniques. A high level of focus, physical control, and prior knowledge is expected.

While not required, it is recommended that students have completed Dance 1, 2, and/or 3 before enrolling, especially for participation in the 4th Grade Family Waltz. Students with equivalent training from an accredited studio should request a placement review.

This year-long class meets twice a week (Mondays and Wednesdays), with occasional Saturday Nutcracker rehearsals. Performances include the Winter Wonderland Dec. 13, The Nutcracker Dec. 13, Holiday Celebration Dec. 18, and the Elementary Spring Arts Festival on May 15
