

(Gr. 5) Improvisation

This course will focus on comedic and dramatic improvisations, and will be geared toward encouraging students to fully commit to their creative choices and to embrace leadership opportunities. The more advanced warm-ups, as well as the games and exercises, will aid in a greater focus on the individual (while continuing group work).
